This week I am dedicating the newsletter to sharing with you what some of the fund raising that we have completed over the year has helped us to buy. The money raised during our fayres (Winter and Summer), the hamper raffles (Winter, Easter and Summer), the film nights, some of the clubs, enterprise week, welly wang (EYFS) and other events, where parents are generous in their support of school, eventually adds up to enable school to put the money to things that are meaningful to the children and support all areas of their learning. We have recently spent over £3000 on replacing and upgrading the forest school area. The main area of improvement was the decking area that had become rotten over the last 15 years. A massive thank you to Steve Shipp who used the company Plant Timber and who spent 3 days (probably the hottest) moving the poly tunnel, removing and then replacing the timber decking. It looks amazing and will be fabulous for the children to use.

We have also completed the 'grey to green' project with the fantastic Simon Jackson from Jackson's fruit, veg and flowers company in Clay Cross, Simon generously gave up his own time to advise us on the plants and then selflessly gave us a number of days to organise the installation of the seating, planting and building the planters. It has been such a transformation and has been noticed by the children and the staff (who have a cheeky 5 mins out there). Also we have seen an increase in butterflies in the area as well. The next step will be to add wall art and some explore zones for the children. I will share photos next week. Thank you to all our parents who have helped to make these areas a reality from supporting the events that the school puts on. As Asda says 'every penny counts' and look what we can achieve with the funds raised from these events.






This week's work was completed on the transition day by the children in their new classes. They had the most fabulous move up days and we were so proud of the amazing first impressions that they made.







