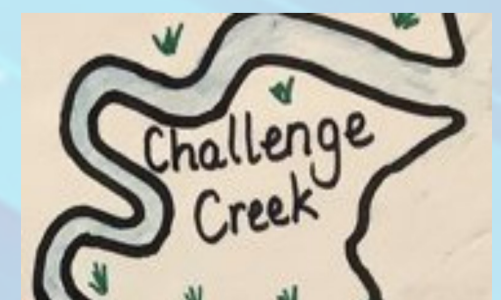
Reminder that Qualitas Camp will be taking place in the first week of the Easter holidays.
