**Our focus next week is...Quality Cove**



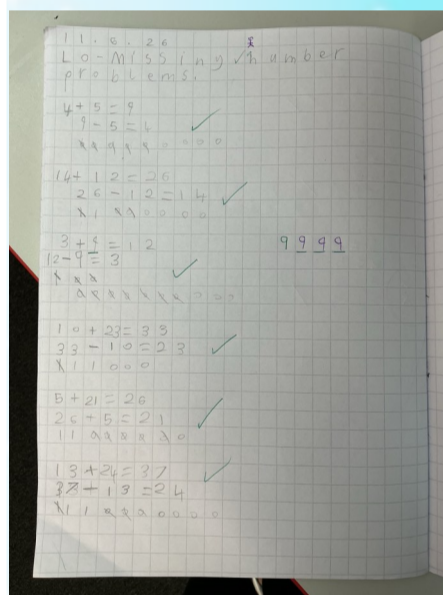
