Wednesday 1st, Thursday 2nd, Friday 3rd July – Transition days

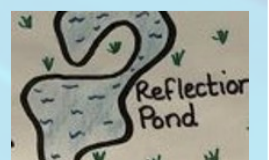
Children will all meet their new teachers and spend time in their new classes in preparation for September!
