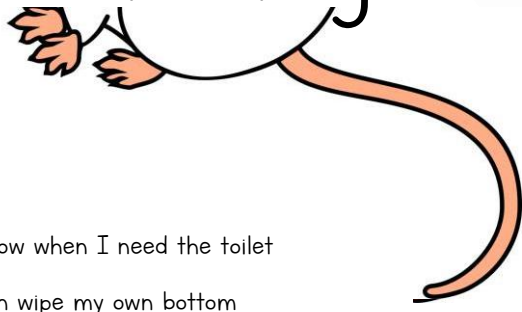


Toileting



- I know when I need the toilet
- I can wipe my own bottom
- I can go to the toilet on my own
- I know to flush the toilet
- I know how to wash my hands



Dressing



- I can take my coat off and put it on
- I can dress with some help
- I can pull up my trousers
- I can complete a zip when started
- I can put on my own shoes (velcro is advised)



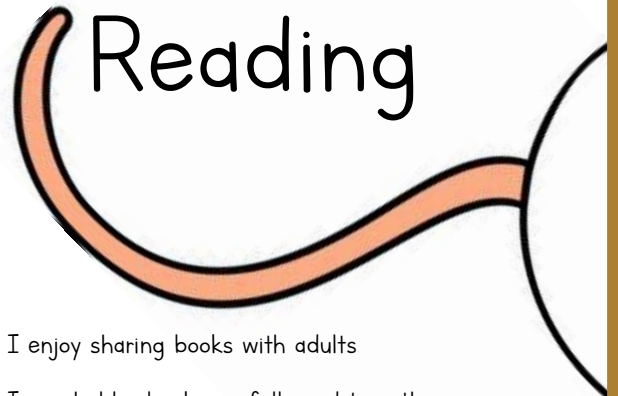
Eating



- I can tell someone if I am hungry
- I can feed myself
- I have started to use cutlery



Reading



- I enjoy sharing books with adults
- I can hold a book carefully and turn the pages
- I know what my favourite book is
- I can talk about the pictures in the books
- I can join in with repeated refrains in books
- I can recognise my own name





Listening and Communication

I can stop what I am doing when asked

I can listen to a simple instruction and complete this

I can tell friends or adults what I need

I can take turns and share when I am playing

I can tell an adult if I am happy or sad

I know that what I do and say can make others happy or sad.



Phonics

I can recognise familiar signs eg. road signs, shop signs.

I can go on a listening walk and recognise sounds such as cars, birds, waves, cows etc...

I can compare and match different instrumental sounds- eg bell, piano

I can sing many songs and action songs

I can read a rhyming story- sometimes completing the rhyming words

I might play I spy games. Thinking about the initial sound of words.

I might be able to say the word, if an adult says 3 sounds to me eg c- a- t.



Numbers

I can sometimes use numbers in my play, eg counting toys, shells on the beach

I can count to 10 with an adult verbally

I can spot numbers when outside eg. road signs, number plates, house numbers.

I know how old I am and can recognise this number

I might recognise numbers 1-6

I might count up to 5 items from a group eg. helping to set the table for 4 people, making a teddy bears picnic.



I can help your child settle in to school!

Physical Development

I can stand momentarily on one foot when shown.


I can catch a large ball.

I can draw lines and circles using large movements.

I use one-handed tools and equipment, eg. makes snips in paper with child scissors.

I can hold a pencil between my thumb and two fingers, no longer using whole-hand grasp.

I can copy some letters, eg. letters from my name
