Fixed Term Exclusion (All pupils on return will spend time in internal exclusion
(Ocean Room) on re-integration programme after a FTE or being taken home by parents)

Please note that the steps do not have to be followed sequentially, depending on the incident or behaviour

Addition to behaviour concerns- If a child's behaviour is deemed of safety high risk, for example, refusing to adhere to safety measures, such as, hand washing, social distancing, remaining in their bubbles or deliberate behaviours that put themselves or others at risk, such as spitting or deliberately coughing at people
